What is this class about?

What will we cover?

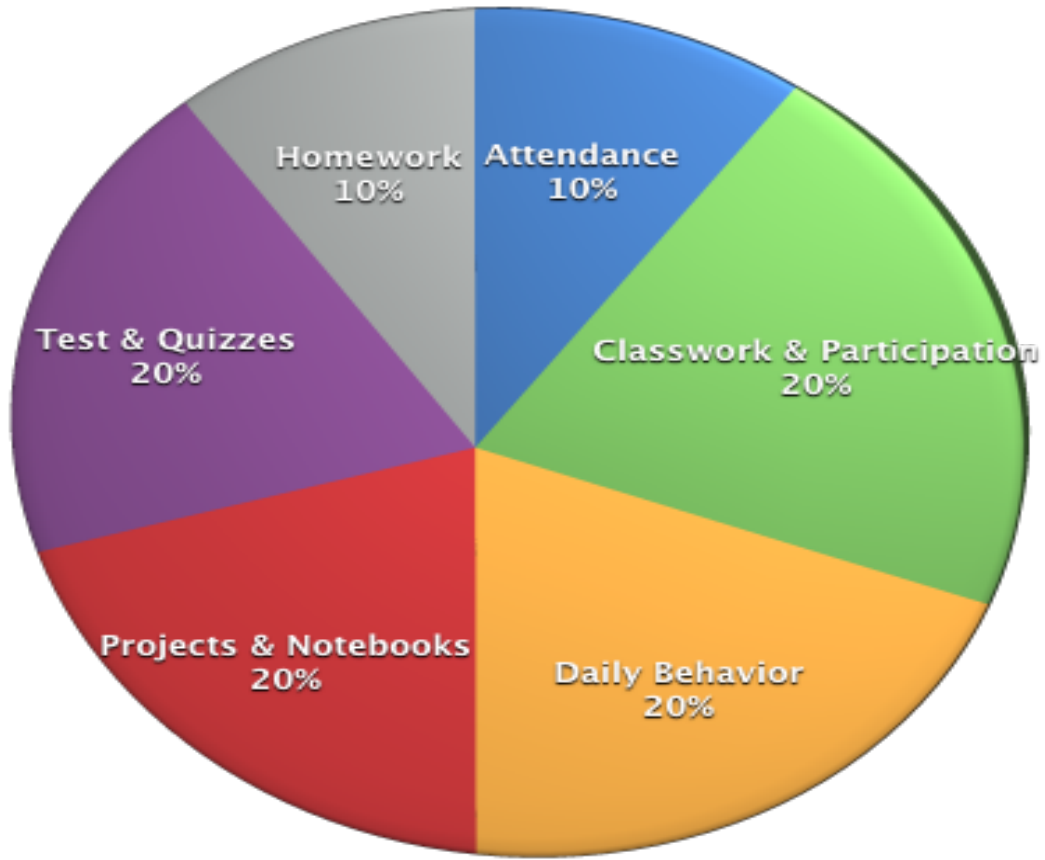
